We went to the beach for some sandcastle competitions

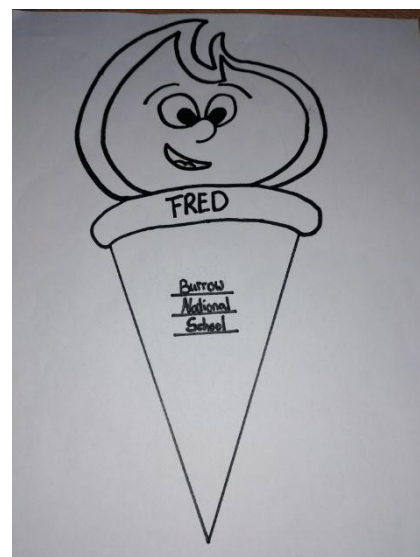


We have been very lucky to have Ms Swindell in with us teaching us all about environmental awareness and leading us as the green school committee.

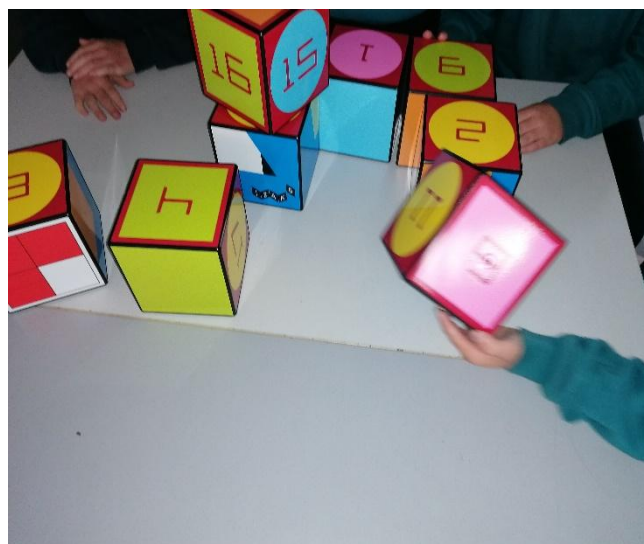
Here are some pictures of us learning about static electricity:
