Although the format has slightly changed this year, we are continuing to learn through Aistear. 'School' was our theme for September and this month's theme is 'Home' and 'Halloween.'

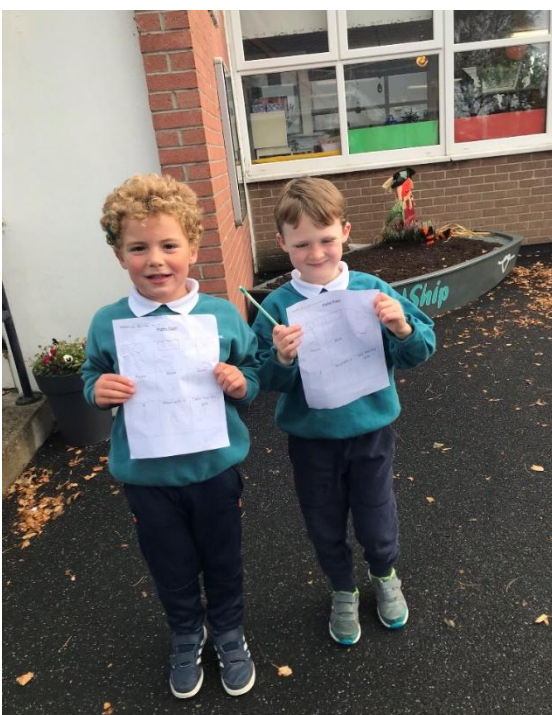




We were learning and talking about road safety. We discussed ways that we can be safe pedestrians. We got the chance to walk across the road safely with Caroline our lollipop lady.
